~ April, May & June 2009 ~

Unto all who read these letters writ, Greetings.

April and May has been a very busy month for me. During this quarter, I've had 50 Registered Arms, 0 Transferred Arms, 16 Returned Arms, 0 Released Arms, and 1 Held Over for Further Research. In addition, I have made 2 Ruling which will be included into the next version of the Heraldry Manual.

As a reminder, Local and Regional heraldic officers are only allowed to hold submissions for (a maximum of) 30 days from time of receipt. The ISoA can hold submissions for (a maximum of) 90 days.

More & more I'm seeing dates of receipt from Local heralds being sent to Regional in excess of three months; one submission being presented to Regional after two years. This is unacceptable!

Next, it is the obligation of EVERY Minister of Arms and EVERY Crown (acting [by default] as their Subdivision's Minister of Arms), to submit a Monthly Report. I expect the report by the end of each month. Please send the report to me, at <u>BaronBish@gmail.com</u>.

\*\*\* FINAL WARNING: Every Minister of Arms WHO DO NO REPORT (as described above) on a consistent basis will have their Imperial College of Arms ranking reduced. Kings/Queens of Arms will be reduced in rank to Herald of Arms, Herald of Arms will be reduced in rank to Pursuivant of Arms, and Pursuivant of Arms will be reduced in rank to Clerk of Arms. [A full report was detailed in my 'ISoA Letter to the Imperial Estates (March 2009)', which was also published in the March 2009 LoRR.] Deputies of the Minister of Arms will subsequently be reduced in rank.

Monthly reports should be a summary of actions taken during the previous month. An example of a 'summary' should mimic the style of my report (below). If you have nothing to report, a simple report of "Nothing to report" is acceptable. Not sending reports when you have nothing to report is *not* acceptable.

I hope to hear from you all soon.

\*NOTE: It is College of Arms policy to correctly blazon the emblazon. The submitter of this Device drew 'maple leaves.' Maple trees (and its leaves) are not period, circa 1700A.D., (which were then transported to Europe and Asia). In conversation with the submitter, I was informed, that although 'maple leaves' were drawn, 'generic' leaves were intended.

\*NOTE: With the charge of a 'hand', the default hand is the dexter hand; the default posture is apaumé and couped. This Badge depicts all three aspects.

**Sebastian Javier de la Cruz** BADGE [Fieldless] a Toulouse cross Gules surmounted by two staffs in saltire each topped by a fleur-de-lis Argent.

**Sorcha Kyrkeby** BADGE [Fieldless] an ermine spot Sable.

**Ysabel de Lisieux** BADGE [Fieldless] a crequier Azure.

**Colbhach Faolan OhAinnan** DEVICE *Quarterly Gules and Or, on a bend Sable three crosses formy Argent.*

DEVICE

Sable, a bear rampant contourné Argent armed, langued and embrued Gules, a bordure compony Gules and Argent.

## Allistar CuChlainn Halliday

DEVICE

(Adjusted Blazon): Or, a semi of thistles slipped and leaved Proper, on an inescutcheon Azure a wolf statant Argent.

\*NOTE: This is clearly a Marshaled device and as such is in violation of the Heraldry Manual (2008), §XI.C.1: [C]: Inescutcheons of pretense are considered to be a form of marshalling and as such are restricted. [1]: For this restriction to apply, the inescutcheon must be in the shape of an escutcheon.

DEVICE – Estate (House)

(Adjusted Blazon): Per chevron inverted Vert and Sable a Griffin segreant and three eggs Or.

\*NOTES:

(1) Returned by Griffin Queen of Arms (Deputy ISoA – West); REASON: Eggs are not a period charge.

(2) Violates Heraldry Manual (2008) §XI.D; [see: "Rules & Rulings — I" (at the end of this LoRR).]

#### Aryanna Vadim

DEVICE *Argent, a chevron Vert.* 

\*NOTE: Returned by Phoenix & Dragon King of Arms (Deputy ISoA – East); REASON: Conflicts with 'Guinevrre Monroe de San Filippo - (Brandenburg)'

#### Aryanna Vadim

DEVICE

Vert, a saltire Argent.

\*NOTE: Returned by Phoenix & Dragon King of Arms (Deputy ISoA – East); REASON: Conflicts with 'Alhambra Minister of Archery' and 'Alhambra Archers of Carleon.'

#### Sade Vadim

DEVICE

Argent, a chevron and a chevron inverted Vert.

(Possible Blazon): Argent, a mascle fesswise throughout Vert.

\*NOTE: Returned by Phoenix & Dragon King of Arms (Deputy ISoA – East); REASON: Improper display of chevrons.

## **Brammer Glen**

DEVICE – Estate (Barony)
Vert, a chief dancetty, in base two bars wavy Argent
\*NOTE: Returned by Griffin Queen of Arms (Deputy ISoA – West); REASON: 1
PoD (Point of Difference) from Ekateringorod.

# Pembroke

#### Calais

DEVICE – Estate (County)
Sable, on a fess coisted Argent between in pale two fleur-de-lis Or a fleur-de-lis Sable.
\*NOTE: Returned by Phoenix & Dragon King of Arms (Deputy ISoA – East);
REASON: Violation of the Heraldry Manual (2008), §VIII.B.1: [VIII] "Restricted Titles and Charges", [B] "The Fleur-de-lis", [1] "Gold (Or)".

#### Helen de la Cruz

DEVICE

Gules, a cross bottony Or, in chief Sable three stags tripant Argent.

\*NOTE: Returned by Phoenix & Dragon King of Arms (Deputy ISoA – East);

REASON: Submitted on an outdated submission form. The current form can be found in the "Library => Forms" section of the AdrianEmpire.org website [http://www.adrian empire.org/library-forms.php].

## Mycenae

DEVICE – Estate (House)

Gules, an eagle displayed double-headed Or within a serpent biting it's tail in annulo Argent.

\*NOTES:

(1) Violation of Ruling made in the '2008-08\_09\_10\_11 LoRR': "A dragon (or other beasts), (other than a serpent or snake or the like) in the position 'in annulo' cannot be registered in Adria.

(2) This 'serpent' depicted in the emblazon of the Device submitted does not appropriately show a 'serpent' but a 'dragon-headed snake', which is not the same as a 'serpent'. My heraldic research shows emblazons of a 'snake' and a 'serpent' to be virtually interchangeable.

(3) It is my ruling that the emblazon provided shows (a form of) a 'dragon'. If this Device was resubmitted with the appropriate head of a 'snake' or a 'serpent', then the submission will be reconsidered without prejudice.

# Ozzy

DEVICE (Local Blazon) Argent, a ladybug Proper, a bordure Gules.

\*NOTES:

(1) Returned by Phoenix & Dragon King of Arms (Deputy ISoA – East); REASON: A 'ladybug' is not a period charge.

(2) My suggestion is to re-submit as a 'beetle' tergiant (an overhead view of the beast [as it crawls along]) or a 'scarab.'

DEVICE

Vert, a bend Sable between a fox sejant and a fox sejant contourne Argent

\*NOTE: Returned by Phoenix & Dragon King of Arms (Deputy ISoA – East); REASON: Violation of the Heraldry Manual (2008), §IV.A: "Colour on Colour."

## Wolf

DEVICE

Sable, a base Purpure, a wolf sejant head erect and in chief two mullets of 8 Or.

\*NOTE: Returned by Phoenix & Dragon King of Arms (Deputy ISoA – East); REASON: Violation of the Heraldry Manual (2008), §IV.A: "Colour on Colour."

#### BADGE

Sable, a wolf's head caboshed Or, a bordure Purpure.

\*NOTE: Returned by Phoenix & Dragon King of Arms (Deputy ISoA – East); REASON: Violation of the Heraldry Manual (2008), §IV.A: "Colour on Colour."

## Zachariah of the Red Band

DEVICE

Azure, on a fess Gules three mullets of 6 Argent.

\*NOTE: Returned by Phoenix & Dragon King of Arms (Deputy ISoA – East); REASON: Submitted on multiple versions of submission forms. The current form can be found in the "Library => Forms" section of the AdrianEmpire.org website [http://www. adriaempire.org/library-forms.php].

## DEVICE

Sable, on a fess coisted Argent between in pale two fleur-de-lis Or a fleur-de-lis Sable.

\*NOTE: Returned by Phoenix & Dragon King of Arms (Deputy ISoA – East); REASON: Violation of the Heraldry Manual (2008), §IV.C.2: [C] "Fieldless Armoury," [2] "Fieldless armory must form itself a unified whole; all elements in the design must be conjoined."

(Adjusted Blazon) Pily of 9 abased Argent and Sable, in chief a dog's collar spiked Azure.

\*NOTE: A 'dog's collar' (spiked or otherwise) is not a period charge. Additionally, a plain 'collar' is not used as a separate (individual) charge, except when mentioned as 'collared', 'gorged' or 'gorged and chained'.

**Order of the Spade – (Or)** BADGE (Cyprus) [Fieldless] a spade Or.

\*NOTE: While compiling this report (at the Northeast Imperial Banner War 2009), Her Imperial Majesty (who was in attendance) informed me of the existence of the Badge of the 'Imperial Order of the Golden Spoon,' which this Badge would be in conflict with. I searched the College of Arms Registry of Arms database and did not see the Badge of the Imperial Order of the Golden Spoon listed.

I am holding this submission over, to research if the Badge of this Order is in conflict with the original intended (but not registered in a LoRR, but listed in the Imperial Ordinary [2007]) Badge.

# ~ <u>Rules & Rulings</u> ~

I.

**TOPIC:** "Restrictions on Marshalling [Supplemental]: "Per Chevron" and "Per Chevron Inverted"

Currently, this section reads:

*"Heraldry Manual (2008) — §XI.D: RESTRICTIONS ON MARSHALLING Research has shown that Marshalling appeared in more than just the familiar forms* 

of Per Pale and Quarterly. This includes the hitherto-unrestricted Per Fess and Per Saltire divisions. These divisions have been abused in Adrian armory to allow designers to combine disparate elements on one shield against the spirit of the Marshalling proscription. In keeping with our overall push to encourage Period design, the following is now disallowed:

Any design wherein the field is divided Per Pale, Per Fess, Per Bend, Per Bend Sinister, Quarterly, Per Saltire, Per Pall, and Per Pall Inverted wherein the charges on either side of the line of division are of different types."

There were two field divisions that were accidentally excluded: "Per Chevron" and "Per Chevron Inverted" which I here now include to this section of the Heraldry Manual (2008):

"Any design wherein the field is divided Per Pale, Per Fess, Per Bend, Per Bend Sinister, Quarterly, Per Saltire, Per Pall, Per Pall Inverted, Per Chevron, and Per Chevron Inverted wherein the charges on either side of the line of division are of different types."

## II.

#### **TOPIC: "Single Tincture as Arms"**

It has been ruled by past ISoA's that the registering a single tincture (i.e., metal, colour, fur) as the complete Device or Badge, without any sort of field division or charge is unacceptable. A 'single tincture' as a complete blazon would create too many problems against simple Arms registration(s).

I concur with the previous ruling; 'Single Tincture' Arms are not registrable.
