
WHAT IS AN OUTLANDER?

A resident is a current member of Adria who lives in the region. An outlander is anyone else (not a member of Adria, or lives in some other region).

HOW ARE THEY DIVIDED?

When all is said and done, the outlanders should number in the same ratio as the resident armies. If Army A has 100 members, and Army B has 50, then the outlanders should be divided 2:1.

IS THIS FOR EVERY WAR?

No. The only wars that this method of division is required is for Crown Wars (both local and Imperial).

WHO COUNTS TOWARD THE RESIDENT ARMIES?

All current Adrian members who live in the region, and are participating in the war (archery, arts or combat).

HOW DO I DETERMINE THE SIZE OF THE RESIDENT ARMIES?

Count the number of residents (from the arts, archery and combat sign-in sheets, not the event sign-in sheets) for each army. Be very careful not to double-count any members! (Hint: Print out a member list for the region and use that to mark the member's army preference. Once you have marked him based on the arts sign-in, you will not be able to count him again based on the archery sign-in.)

DOES FEALTY COUNT?

Yes, as long as the bylaws aren't violated - the ratio **MUST** be in proportion to the residents.

WHAT IF I'M AN OUTLANDER AND I CAN'T FIGHT IN THE ARMY I WANT?

Crown Wars are fought to determine who will "rule" a region for the next term of office. That is a decision for the residents. Your wishes can be accommodated as long as the ratio is okay. If you can't fight where you want, you can either withdraw and function as a minister (judge, marshal, etc.), or fight for your "new" army. This is an honor-based group, so you will need to be impartial if you are a minister, or fight 100% for the army to which you are assigned. If you can't do either of those things, hang out and have fun at the campfire when the war is over.

DOES MY WITHDRAWAL FROM THE ARMY AFFECT THE WAR?

Yes. It affects the ratio of outlanders. If you find that you cannot fight on your chosen army, and choose to withdraw rather than fight for the other army, then you must say so when you are being assigned to an army. At the end of the outlander division, the ratio will be double-checked for accuracy.

REFERENCE FROM THE BYLAWS:

ARTICLE XVI.A.3. CROWN WAR. CONDUCT OF THE WAR. RECRUITING.

"...At this time, the visiting members and participants shall be chosen by the contenders for their force. The distribution of all visiting members and participants shall be in proportion to the size of the armies as set by the choice of the membership of the chartered subdivision."

ARTICLE XVI.D.3. CROWN WAR. IMPERIAL CROWN WAR. RECRUITING.

"...At this time visitors and participants shall be allotted to various armies in proportion to the size of the armies as set by the choice of the membership of the Adrian Empire."
