Some Stern Words to Crowns & Stewards

Several recent incidents and (horrifying) conversations have brought to light that people are ignoring and violating proper procedures in their Steward's office. The procedures for business and corporations is not that different from individuals, so we wonder that people think they can just vote to dismiss these procedures. You can't, We can't. What follows is the two most basic elements of tax law, which are the same for your household as they are for us. Please take this seriously.

No receipt, no reimbursement! You cannot, as an individual, take any deductions without a receipt. Why

would anyone think its different for a business or corporation. This is not something the local subdivision can decide to do. As We have repeatedly discussed at Imperial Estates Meetings if there is no receipt there can be no reimbursement. Any monies advanced which no receipts can be produced for have to be repaid to the Empire. Any monies expended on the behalf of the Empire

cannot be reimbursed with out a receipt produced. What you can do if a receipt is lost is get a "replacement receipt". First contact the business to see if they can issue you a replacement. If not then you will have to write out a personal voucher stating date, time, name and location of the business, the items purchased and the amount of the purchase along with your name, address, and signature. The Estates can vote to find the replacement acceptable, but they cannot vote to require no receipt. If the Empire or your subdivision is ever audited and the IRS reviews your receipt they will make a determination as to whether they accept it. If they don't you may become liable for the amount. What you absolutely cannot do is purchase goods or services from providers who do not want to provide a receipt because they are operating illegally by not declaring income. Should you decide to send such business to one of your buddies then you must provide a receipt yourself, and you can declare the income and pay their taxes as your own. You cannot, repeat cannot, expend funds without receipt. Any subdivision doing so is jeopardizing their own standing and the Empires standing.



No co-mingling of funds! Funds collected for a business or non-profit corporation must be not be processed through an individual's bank accounts. This is called "co-mingling", and it is against the law. When collecting cash proper procedure is to either deposit it directly to an Adrian Empire banking account, or convert it by means of purchasing a money order made payable to the subdivision or Empire's bank account. Money orders can be bought at post offices, banks, some grocery stores, and many convenience stores. The charge to purchase them

is a valid administrative expense, and should simply be declared as such. What you cannot do is deposit the funds into your own account and then write a personal check to the subdivision (or Empire) for the amount. In depositing funds to your own account, as far as the IRS is concerned, it becomes personal income which you could be held accountable for paying taxes on. The

other reason this is illegal is because individuals could use it as a vehicle to claim tax deductions on funds that they are simply handling for others.

No vote of any estates, local or imperial, can abrogate these requirements. Any Steward, Crown, or Estates that does so will be considered unfit to administer their own estate and risk losing their status.

& A Word to the Rolls Offices

You may not realize it, but your reporting is linked to our tax responsibilities. Because individuals can deduct expenses for traveling to and from our activities as "volunteers" we have to keep records on their attendance. And you thought it was just about advancing to knighthood... we'll so do most of us. But reality is, should someone be audited that has claimed expenses related to attending an event the IRS will come looking for confirmation of that claim. Our status as a non-profit is given with the responsibility that we will keep competent records of donations satisfactory to the IRS. So, even if you don't know who won what list it's important to get the list of attendee/participants. This is especially true for demos and Estates meetings.

So, Onward...

We're pleased to say that most of Our reign We've had the indulgence of mostly thanking people for their efforts. And We are really proud of the advancements that have been made across the Empire with bringing business current, especially in the Steward's offices. So please, let's make a real effort to focus now on the details of how these offices should be run from here on out.

Imperial Archery Tournament for Invitational Steel Tournament

It will be shot at any practice or tournament conducted between August 30, 2001 through October 28, 2001. Scores will be collected by the local archery minister or, in absence of the minister, the Crown or any Knight the Crown designates for this purpose. The standard 60cm FITA target will be used. If the 60cm is not available you may use an accurate facsimile. All courses to be fired at 20 yards. A score sheet with game name, real name will be forwarded to Sir Karl von Katzburg at ontis@compuserve.com not later than October 31, 2001 via e-mail. If formatting fails the scores can not be counted so be alert for correspondence concerning formatting.

All targets for the Imperial Archery Tournament October 2001:

Targets will be scored as follows: the inner yellow circle 10X the middle yellow circle: 10 the outer yellow circle: 9 the inner red circle: 8 the outer red circle: 7 the inner blue circle: 6 the outer blue circle: 5 the inner black circle: 4 the outer black circle: 3 the inner white circle: 2 the outer white circle: 1

Course of fire:

- 6 arrows, slow fire standing
- 6 arrows, slow fire kneeling or sitting
- Rapid fire as many arrows as can be shot in 30 seconds. You must draw your own arrows from the ground or your quiver or belt no assistance is allowed.
