Greetings unto the Empire,

It has been a pleasure to serve you these first two months. Although it saddens Us, and We had hoped to avoid a situation like this during Our reign, We must address a serious matter. A few of Our officers and officials are considered administrators and it is clear that some are unfamiliar with the proper procedures concerning chattel property. There are strict rules concerning self-dealing and We cannot allow Adria to violate them even unintentionally. We, the Imperial Crowns, have consulted with Adrian members that are legal and financial professionals, current Crowns, and several Imperial family members. It has been universally stated to Us by all of these sources that the practices that occurred are unacceptable, both within Adria, and more importantly, mundanely.

Be it known, here and now, that We, the Imperial Crowns, decree that NO Adrian Crown, Steward, nor custodian of chattel shall sell that chattel to themselves, their families, or any close relation. Furthermore, all chattels no longer needed MUST be sold at a fair market value. Also, any reimbursement to a member for physical goods makes those goods or anything produced from those goods property of the Empire. Anyone who violates this order from this point forward should expect consequences. For those who may have already done this we are declaring a 30 day general amnesty. Provided that during this period an honest attempt to reverse these transactions or to set up methods to undo the damages is made, We will declare their incidences closed without punitive actions.

It grieves Us to have to pursue something that many feel is an obvious wrong. We do not wish to make this more difficult than it has to be, but We must comply with the requirements of mundane law. We will be introducing additions to our Bylaws that are more in line with modern requirements of new non-profit organizations. We fervently hope that this will no longer be an issue.


- <u>Once a month, within 30 days of the last event in that calendar month</u>, the local Office of Rolls and Lists sends the original sign-in forms for the previous month to the Imperial Office of Rolls and Lists. The local Office should keep copies and is encouraged to do so. See *V.A.2. Physical Reporting (Sending in the Paperwork)* on page 18.
- The Imperial Office of Rolls and Lists reviews the paperwork, handles questions that arise from the paperwork, compares the paperwork to the information in the Imperial Database, and verifies the entry of each event in the *Imperial Database within 90 days*.

If there is anything I or one of my Deputies can do to help please let us know.



I have been following the thread concerning arrows and wanted to be sure that I would be able to describe my thoughts and experiences with breaking arrows before I posted into this discussion.

I sometimes intend to say one thing but it comes out quite differently. As human beings, I believe that all of us do this at one time or another. I hope this is not one of those times for me.

Since I have accepted the position of Imperial Minister of Archery, I am still trying to figure out my actual role for interjecting my thoughts and emotions into the conversations. I am not trying to "pass the buck" or ignore any issues. I am new to this type of position and I will try not to upset any of my fellow Adrians.

In regards to the current discussion concerning the issue of breaking arrows, I would like to clarify what I meant when I was speaking to Sir Thorn, whom I regard as a very influential gentleman.

Let me be clear that I am talking about TARGET archery, not combat archery.

In my own experience at an Imperial War, I saw the results of an arrow being too short for the DRAW of an archer. This particular arrow was drawn back so far that the arrow point was behind the bow riser. On release the arrow did NOT clear the bow, but instead it hit the bow and, under the pressure of the release, the arrow splintered into 3or 4 pieces and sliced into the arm of the Knight Archer. It was quite messy, painful and embarrassing for him. This archer had cut down his arrows because he felt that they were too long when he purchased them, and he could not control them.

When we cut down, or shorten, our arrows, I feel that we should take a measurement by putting an arrow in the bow and pull to your full draw. Have some one there to take a measurement and then add 3/4" to the length (this is a suggestion not a rule).

All Range Masters or Ministers should be watching the archers and be sure that the arrow is sticking out 3/4 " past the bow when it is at full draw.

The breaking of arrows is not the fault of the bow or the string. This is simply an arrow measurement discrepancy.

I simply want all of our archery events to be fun for us, but above all else I want them to be safe for everyone. I am not saying that everyone is using the wrong arrows, but if we can prevent even one accident or painful injury, then that is what this is all about. I have been in contact with HIM Empress Etaine, and we are gathering information to devise an Archery test that All PERSONS that might be in charge of the archery range at any Adrian event must take and pass in order to be qualified to run the archery ranges safely and knowledgeable.

These tests will become available as soon as they are approved and I will notify you as soon as possible there after.

# A Traveler's Journey of Italian Masterpieces Part 2 By Sir Ansel de Gace



Title: The Annunciation

Artist: Fra Angelico (1387 – 1455)

Location: Museo di San Marco (The San Marco Convent restored in 1437 by Cosimo de' Medici the Elder), Florence, Italy (specifically in a corridor of a convent – the top of the stairs where the cloister began for the monks)

To see a piece of art in its original setting was a pleasing experience. I am not sure how other experiences of artwork placed later by curators or potentates will compare. The Annunciation's purpose is such a large part of the total purpose of the monastery: to develop a deeper connection to God. Perhaps it was the circumstances of the visit: from the noise and bustle of the city to the serenity of the cloister or even my expectations of seeing a small plate from a book in its full dimension, scale, and setting, but it was a dramatic moment at the landing when I turned and saw Mary confronted with Gabriel.



Flow-wise, I remember locking eyes on Mary's face then down to her hands, across to Gabriel's crossed wrists and up to his face. The high pattern area of the garden and landscape contrasted nicely with smooth loggia. Gabriel's wings seemed to provide a bridge between the two areas in both a literal and figurative way: he is a messenger from another world as well as a physical connection between the outside and inside. He unifies human and divine when he touches down to give the announcement as Mary unifies them by being a human touched by the divine. I suppose there's the coarser reading of the angel being the metaphysical phallus being at the entrance to the womb-like loggia to deliver the news and perhaps be a channel for the Holy Spirit that will impregnate Mary – it's a little too Freudian for me, though, and it seems unlikely to be the intent of the Brother. His use of perspective makes the world seem orderly and clean — the light and luminous colors he uses make this very realistic perspective seem almost unreal, or better said, it is otherworldly.



## A Traveler's Journal of Italian Masterpieces

The narrative of the figures is what excited me most though. The pained expression, as I read it, on Mary's face was surprising and added greater human dimension to the piece. Gabriel appears to be just recovering from a deep bow and his hands mirror Mary's – it seems he is doing his best to relate to her. Mary's left hand seems to define the shape of her soon to grow belly. Brother Angelico captures the moment of the announcement, Mary's shock and Gabriel's compassion and it marks the beginning of Jesus' time on earth: a wonderful reminder to his fellow monks of their devotion to the gospels. I can imagine making my way up the spiral stair, after a day of work and prayer to see the beautiful, luminous fresco, pausing to take it in and feeling refreshed.
