Another item I would like to see occur is more time being taken to check the safety of all archery equipment. There SHOULD be a designated time allotted at every event to check all bows, strings, nocks, points and shafts. This (again) would fall on the Range Master/Minister to be certain all is safe.

If ANY equipment is questionable, it SHOULD not be permitted for use on the range until it is corrected and reinspected. The Range Master/Minister has the final say. Safety first !!

Since November I have been receiving regular reports from the Arch Kingdom of Connacht, Bisqaia and from the SE from the Kingdom of York, Arch Duchy of Castellon de Leon's, and Duchy of Pembroke.
