



Imperial Order of the Croix Fleury

This is a non-voting order and membership in the Order grants the precedence of Vicount/Vicountess (non-founding).

Candidates for this order must hold atleast 1st Level Knighthood in each knightly discipline.

The heraldry for the Order is:

Or, a cross fleury voided azure between four roses proper.

Candidates petitioning for membership into the Imperial Order of the Croix Fleury shall be paid members in good standing of the Adrian Empire. Candidates may petition any member of the Order, be recommended by a member of the Order, be recommended by their Local Crown or by the Imperial Crowns. Once a petition or recommendation is received, it shall be forwarded to the current Senior Member of the Order for verification of qualifications. The Senior Member of the Order shall either contact the Local Minister of Rolls or the Imperial Minister of Rolls for verification of knightly status. The Senior Member of the Order shall also contact the Imperial Steward for verification of membership status. Upon verification of qualifications of the candidate, the Senior Member of the Order shall notify the candidate of acceptance into the Order.

Advancement in the order shall be by attaining additional levels of knighthood. Each level of knighthood will be assigned (1) one point. Once

the point valve has been achieved, the title and standing within the order is increased. See table for point/title correlation.

The above depicts 2nd level Combat & Ministry, 3rd level Arts &science and archery

For each 2nd level knighthood, a red bezant may be displayed in the appropriate quadrant.

For each 3rd level knighthood, a blue bezant may be displayed in the appropriate quadrant.

Anyone attaining 3rd level in all disciplines a single purple bezant in the center of the croix fleury.

A member of the Imperial Order of the Croix Fleury may only be removed as part of a Judicial Ban, Revocation of Membership, Banishment from the Empire, Loss of Knightly rank or voluntary withdraw.

Membership shall be placed on inactive status for lapses in Adrian Membership Dues and will be reinstated upon payment of dues.
