



The Adrian Empire

L'Bete and Gabriele, by the Grace of God and Will of the Estates, Emperor and Empress of the Catholic and Sovereign Empire of Adria; Kings of Aleon, Navarre, and Pembroke; Dukes of Annelynerose, Brittany, Calais, Isle-de-Fleur, and Snowden; Barons of Isenwold, Grenfeld, Hanover, and Lyon; Lords of the

Outlands and Islands; and Sovereigns of all Their Other Lands and Territories, to Their Patriarch, Archbishops, Bishops, and Clerics; Kings, Princes, and Dukes; Earls, Viceroys, and Viscounts; Champions, Doctors, Premiers, and Wardens; Justicars, Sheriffs, and Governors; Knights, Masters, and Ministers; and all Their faithful subjects:

Greetings,

Be it known to all to whom these presents come that We, L'Bete and Gabriele, Emperor and Empress of all Adria, do hereby grant this Amended Charter to the Duchy of Alhambra according to Our Laws and Customs, as amended by the Imperial Estates in November anno ludus xxx, being mmxvi in the Common Era.

We do hereby charge the Crowns of Alhambra with this land, and reaffirm unto them the following powers and responsibilities:

To report to Us on the State of the Duchy; To appoint a Minister of Rolls, a Steward, and any other ministerial position as is needed, each of whom shall report to their corresponding Imperial Minister; To represent the Duchy unto the Imperial Estates; To create and oversee Estates within the boundaries of the Duchy; To hold demonstrations, events, and meetings in accordance with the Bylaws of the Empire. Ducal Codicils and Writs must be approved by the Imperial Crown. All these conditions will be in accordance with Adrian Law & Custom.

We, according to Our Laws, do hereby fix territory of the Duchy of Alhambra to be Spokane, Pend Oreille, Klickitat, Garfield, and Asotin Counties within the mundane State of Washington; furthermore, the Duchy of Alhambra shall share with the Chapter of Roanoke the lands of Whitman County in the mundane State of Washington and Benewah, Boundary, Bonner, Kootenai and Latah Counties in the mundane State of Idaho.

It is also sworn, both on Our part, and on that of the Estates, that all the aforesaid shall be observed in good faith, and without any evil intention.
