Archers Pass Time in Winter

As the year approaches the time of the sleeping Earth, here is some advice for the archer and thrower to pass their time...

Profile: Duchy of Cambridge

I look back fondly on the events that have led us to where we are - a recently-elevated duchy. The origins of Cambridge are with one man who made a journey to the Kingdom of York. Lord Darion Kiriakis had a chance encounter with Sir Alejandro Vergara, who introduced him to Adria. The seeds were planted that would blossom into Cambridge. Lord Darion journeyed back to the north, and told me about what he saw in York. He and I have embarked on a number of journeys together - right away I pledged my support.

Thus we began our campaign to bring Adria to New York. Princess Maedb (then Empress, and in many ways Cambridge's mother) contacted us in February of this year. After this, we began recruiting in earnest. On our founding at the end of March, we had 5 active members. Two months later we had a fully functional ministry and 20 members.

Spring saw a great many changes, the first of which was our first estate minor - Clan Kyoudai. We also formed the Canton of Avebury with governor Mika Moondancer, formerly of Esperance. Summer saw two more estates minor come into being - House Larethian, and the Brotherhood of the Sacred Light. Our next major milestone was the induction of our very own Auren Benedict into the Order of the Star of Adria in September. It was at this time, I resigned as Viceroy to make room for my successor, Lord Auren (and first Duke of Cambridge on December 21st).

The November Imperial Estates meeting saw Cambridge rise to the status of Duchy. It saw the duchy receive the Rising Star of Adria. It saw long-time member, the former Viceroy of Avernus, and one of the most honorable and gracious combatants I know being, inducted into the Imperial Order of the Lion (Greyland Winter). And it saw me becoming one of the newest Lords of the Empire.

Looking back on what we have accomplished in our short history fills me with joy. Knowing that the populace of Cambridge worked so hard to get where they are makes me glad to have served as its Viceroy.

Medicinal Herbs

The use of herbs in medieval medicine was widespread. The Sisters of St. John feel that agrimony and betony would be helpful to stockpile, and that linen was also needed. Why?

With the coming of a harsh winter, there would be much sickness and injury; colds and fevers from exposure and dampness, lung diseases and burns from the indoor fires, wounds from tumbles taken outside in the poor weather.

Agrimony was extensively used for wounds. When mixed with mugwort and vinegar, it was used for back pain. A wonderful herb, it was also called cocklebur or sticklewort. While a common herb, it was used in great quantity. Betony was good for the sweats. It grew in the woods, so would not be that common among the grapevines around the abbey.

Linen, of course was used for bandages, wash cloths, and bed coverings.



The Church of Adria

The Church of Adria is a non-religious entity within the Empire to help in Ceremonies as well as represent the presence of Clergy during the time of Adria. Recently the Church has reorganized, ratifying their new charter in the September synod. With this charter comes new Church offices; Holy Scribe, Archivist, Holy Steward, and Grand Inquisitor. The Church has on a course of study for those in the Church to measure/track advancement.

Through the office of the Holy Scribe, the Church has organized Adrian ceremonies by type in *The Ceremonial Handbook of the Adrian Empire* (also *Coronations* and *Knighting Ceremonies*) available on the Imperial web site. The Church of Adria hopes to become more active on both a subdivision and Empire-wide level, taking a more active role in the various ceremonies performed throughout Adria.

It is possible for anyone (knight or not) to dedicate themselves to the Church of Adria. The Patriarch has the ability to create awards to reward the faithful. It is the hope of the Church that legislation will soon be created which will create a fund for the Church that will be used to purchase various articles and regalia to be used in performing Ceremonies (to be overseen by the Imperial Steward in accordance with bylaws). No monies whatsoever will come from the Empire. This would simply be to establish a treasury for the Church to buy regalia for the head of the Church.

We hope to develop pilgrimages within various subdivisions to encourage travel to other subdivisions. Those completing pilgrimages will be granted a symbol (possibly an augmentation, to be worked out with the Imperial SoA). Money raised from these pilgrimages will be placed in the Church's fund. It is also the Church's intention to produce various relics which can be purchased by the populace of the Empire.

We will be keep the Empire updated on our activities. We will announce any new orders, awards, and members. Anyone who wants to be an active member of the Church should contact His Eminence or visit the Church of Adria Yahoo group.

I wish to remind everyone that the Adrian College of Arms is not a democracy. It is an advisory and expert body on whom the Fleur de Lys King of Arms relies for aid and advice in performing his duties. I hope to rely on the College heavily in achieving the College's goals. I have several goals for the college this year, and I am open to suggestions.

1. The CoA will prepare a roll of arms for the Imperial Orders. We need cooperation from the Ministers of Rolls to get names. After that, someone needs to prepare a roll of arms. Volunteers?
2. Thanks to Sir Nigel's diligence, we finally have an Ordinary. What remains to be done is coding to make it an electronically searchable document. I'd like not less than two people working on this so that we can make sure as little as possible is missed.
3. The CoA web site will be a seamless part of the Imperial site for a consistent and professional appearance. Sir Nigel is passing to me a huge volume of material that he has developed that other heralds in the empire could benefit from.
4. If converting the CoA's records to electronic format is feasible, a complete copy of the office's records can be disseminated to the College.
5. One of the ongoing problems of the college is timely response to member submissions. I hope developing an electronic submissions process will help (it can run parallel to the present paper process). I'm open to suggestions on the details and definitely looking for a person to spearhead this.

Coronation Report

My Lords and Ladies, herewith is the report on the Awards, Orders, Knighthoods, and Elevations that were granted at Imperial Coronation 2002.

With the approval of the Imperial Estates, the Shire of Cambridge was elevated by Their Imperial Majesties to the rank of **Duchy**.

The **Rising Star of Adria** is given to young Estates within the Empire for exceeding all expectations with recruitment, enthusiasm, or excellence. Receiving the Rising Star of Adria was the Duchy of Cambridge.

The **Royal Star** is given to individuals new to medieval recreation who better the Empire and its populace through their enthusiasm and dedication. Receiving the Star of Adria were Lady Cimindri dela Fort (Umbria), Master Drake Highwind (York), and Master Rowen McAllystre (Brandenburg).

The **Royal Order of the Queen's Guard** is granted to the most noble of our combatants, who display extraordinary skill, chivalry, and style on the battlefield. Receiving the Order of the Queen's Guard was Lord Warren Anthony (Aragon).

The Empress grants the **Order of the Golden Spoon** to those who show consistent excellence in the culinary arts. Receiving the Order of the Golden Spoon was Lady Alyssa ap Nudd (York).

The **Royal Order of the Crown Companions** is given to individuals who display high standards of chivalry and good fellowship who by their period activities and demeanor contribute to the enjoyment and realism of events. Created as Companions of the Imperial Crown were: His Royal Majesty, Sir Elric Meladius of York, Her Royal Majesty, Dame Kendra Finster McFayden de McDonnon of Terre Neuve, and Sir Coda der Dracheson (Esperance).

The **Imperial Orders of the Lion, Harp, Quill and Talbot** are the four non-knightly Orders created to reward prowess in the various fields of endeavor. Receiving the **Order of the Lion** for excellence in combat were Lord Valance Prize (Umbria), and Master Greyland Winter (Cambridge). Receiving the **Order of the Harp** for excellence in the arts were Master David Whitaker (Brandenburg), and Lord Gunther the Grey (Terre Neuve). Receiving the **Order of the Quill** for excellence in ministry were Dame Rose of Aberlone (Aragon), Master Giachino Morone Lococo de San Filippo (Esperance), and Lady Annesta Daonnan

(York). Receiving the **Order of the Talbot** for excellence in archery were Dame Margarita DuBois (Umbria), and Master Patrick Gaul (Tierra del Fuego).

In Adria, we are all assumed to be of noble birth. Those who by their chivalry, commitment, courtesy, and comportment prove their nobility are elevated to the rank of **Lord** or **Lady**. Created Lords and Ladies of the Empire were Dame Marcella Visconti (Brandenburg), Kaeyron Maethanos (Cambridge), Sir Connor O'Riordain (Esperance), and Auberon de la Reve (Andorra).

Created as a **Baron of the Imperial Court**, for exemplary noble behavior, was His Grace, Sir Arion Hirsch von Schutzhundheim (Brandenburg).

The **Imperial Order of the Nebula and Comet** are given to one individual each who, through their enthusiasm and dedication, contribute to the betterment of the Adrian Empire and its populace. For his significant contributions, Sir Terrin Greyphis (Esperance) was created as Companion of the Order of the Nebula. For her outstanding contributions, Dame Brynna nan Tolman (Brandenburg) was created as Companion of the Order of the Comet.

The **Crown Seal of Excellence** is given once per reign by the Imperial Crown to non-estate groups for achieving excellence in their field of work. This year's recipients are the members of the Ropemakers' Guild of Aragon.

Knights of the Third Level are Imperial Peers. Four people received accolades as Knights Premiere: Sir Terrin Greyphis, Sir Coda der Dracheson, Dame Maedb Hawkins (Esperance), and Dame Elisabeth Grey (Tierra del Fuego).

The Imperial Estates approved the reign of Maedb and Karl. His Imperial Majesty will receive his title at the end of his second reign. Dame Maedb Hawkins received the title of **Princess of Adria** from Their Imperial Majesties.


